## 2022 Malaria Indicators Study (2022 CMIS)

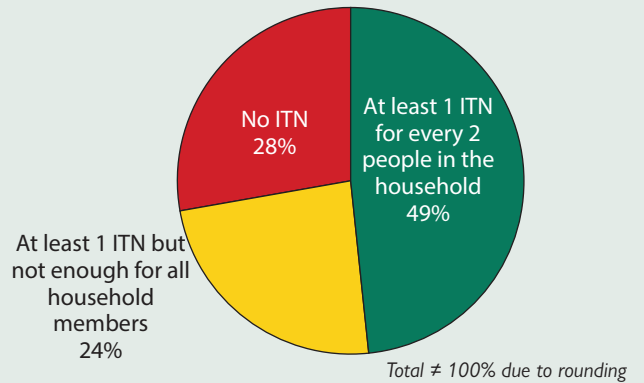
The 2022 CMIS provides information on malaria-related morbidity and coverage of control interventions, measured at the household level. During the CMIS, 6,031 households and 6,532 women age 15-49 were surveyed. In addition, eligible children age 6-59 months were tested for haemoglobin and malaria.

ITN OWNERSHIP

**49%** of households own at least 1 **insecticide-treated net (ITN)** for every 2 people in the household.

**28%** of households do not own an ITN.

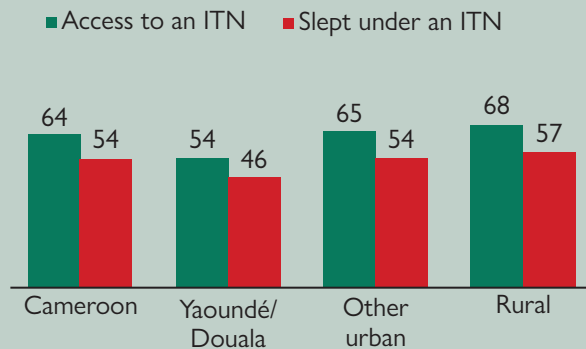
**Household Ownership of ITNs**

ACCESS AND USE OF ITNs

### Access and Use of ITNs by Residence

Percent of household population with access to and ITN and who slept under an ITN the night before the survey



**64%** of household population has access to an ITN.

**54%** of household population slept under an ITN the night before the survey.

MALARIA PREVALENCE

**1 in 4 (26%)** children age 6-59 months tested positive for malaria.

Malaria prevalence is highest in Centre (49%), South (46%), and East (41%) regions.
